

Sample Itinerary Summer 2021/2022 - available from Labour Weekend to Easter

Arrive at The Downtown Ferry Terminal located at 99 Quay St. Here you can purchase your ferry tickets from the Fullers ticket office, or if you have pre-purchased your ferry tickets online, please quote your booking reference number to the staff in the Fullers ticket office to collect your tickets.

- 1200 Depart Auckland on Fullers sailing to Waiheke Island.
- Arrive at Matiatia. You will be greeted on the wharf by Ananda Tours. The tour will commence with a drive along the scenic northern route, taking in spectacular views of the Hauraki Gulf and beyond to the Coromandel Peninsula.
- 1300 Visit Tantalus Estate for a craft beer or wine tasting. This newly renovated winery within the vines offers diverse experiences of wine tastings or enjoy a paddle of their handcrafted ales.
- 1415 Wine tasting and platter lunch at Passage Rock. This is a relaxed venue at the eastern end of Waiheke. Their platter includes sashimi grade trevally kokoda, sticky pork ribs, mozzarella arancini, roast beetroot hummus with goat feta and prosciutto and pear bruschetta. We have vegetarian and gluten free options available.
- 1545 Pick up from lunch venue
- Visit Waiheke Distilling Co. which is set on the ridge above Cowes Bay overlooking the Islands of Pakatoa, Rotoroa and Ponui. This gin distillery has been respectfully established to sit alongside and meld within structures that resonate the farming history of the area. Former pasture land has been painstakingly developed into a garden that exemplifies the botanical story of the product produced, bottled and served onsite. Taste a range of their Waiheke Gin's while learning about gin botanicals and taking in the spectacular view.
