## Sample Itinerary 2024

0900 Depart Auckland on Fullers Ferry to Waiheke Island.

Arrive at Matiatia Wharf where you will be greeted by Ananda Tours and commence your privately guided tour of Waiheke Island. On the way, stunning scenery is around every corner, and you will be entertained by your guide's commentary on the history, geography, culture,

people and produce of Waiheke.

Visit Allpress Olive Oil (formally Rangihoua Estate) where the first olive oil in the North Island was produced. Rangihoua's award-winning olive oils have won many accolades since the first pressings. Here you will learn how the oil is produced and taste a range of different oils, including the peppery Greek-style Koreneiki, the Spanish-style Picual, or the Tuscan-style

Frantoio, as well as island blends.

Visit Batch Vineyard, the highest vineyard on Waiheke Island with north facing sun-soaked hillsides of vines including terraces of traditional and elegant Alsace-style vines close to the winery. There are spectacular 360 degree views over the island and beyond to the gulf islands and Auckland city. Here take part in an in-depth wine experience with the winemaker or General Manager. Visit their onsite winery and enter the barrel hall. Here you will try several wines from barrel, learn about how they make andblend the wines, then move though to enjoy a seated tasting of their top wines accompanied by breads and dips.

Visit **Stonyridge Vineyard** for vertical wine tasting of their flagship wine Larose. Founded in 1982, Stonyridge is a world-class producer of Cabernet blends Larose 2019 was rated 97 points out of 100 by James Suckling. Larose is often considered on of New Zealands top red wines and is sort after by wine collectors around the world.

Lunch at **Tantalus Estate**. This award winning winery within the vines offers a range of beautifully designed spaces including spacious botanical courtyards, comfortable lounge areas, a light and expansive tasting room and the elegant restaurant. The seasonal menu offers refined, tantalising dishes with bold flavours designed to complement the wine and beer made onsite.
