- Visit Waiheke Specialty Foods who showcase the very best produce created by artisan suppliers from Waiheke and across New Zealand. Be hosted by a staff member while you enjoy a small Waiheke tasting platter, including Waiheke Honey Bee honey, Puke O Kai extra virgin olive oil, locally made Focaccia, Waiheke Herb spread, Te Matuku Oysters and a New Zealand Cheese selection. Afterwards if desired, try a local coffee or your choosing from Island Coffee
- 1100 Sit down for a food and wine paired tasting at SOHO Family Wines cellar door. Discover the story behind SOHO and taste a range of their wine matched with morsels of food from their Asian inspired resident food truck, run by Chef Deb a passionate chef with a local cult like following of foodies.
- Relax and enjoy a main dish and glass of wine at **Three Seven Two**. Three Seven Two is named for the first three numbers of the Waiheke phone number, and it's something of a metaphor for this cheerful beach spot, right across the road from Onetangi. The menu, by the excellent Bronwen Laight, formerly of The Shed at Te Motu, is produce-driven and seasonal. Everything is sourced as locally and sustainably as possible to showcase the quality and talent of our home.
- Visit Waiheke's newest destination **The Heke** for a premium single malt whisky and chocolate tasting. Set on 4 acres of gardens with 180 deg views, The Heke is architecturally designed with a relaxed atmosphere. If available, tour their Whisky's stills and learn about the whisky making process before sitting down to try several of their award winning whisky's matched with New Zealand Chocolate.
- 1515 Head back to Oneroa and stop at Island Gelato. Choose your favourite flavour and then we will head down to the beach to enjoy! Their gelato motto is: Creamy, crunchy, chewy and zesty, full bodied in flavour, low in fat and sugar. With 70+ flavours and weekly specials, everything lovingly created in store daily.
